Why movement in the music classroom? Movement allows for creativity, exploration, and composition, while fostering musicianship and teamwork. Focus on using movement activities and traditional folk dances to develop a movement vocabulary. Combine creative movement with works from the Orff Volumes and inspire your students to keep moving with meaning!



Aaron Hansen is a K-6 Music Specialist in the Waverly-Shell Rock School District. He earned both Bachelors and Masters degrees in Music from the University of Northern Iowa. Hansen has completed three levels of Orff-Schulwerk Teacher Training and Orff Master Class at the University of St. Thomas. Hansen has presented workshops for Orff Chapters, State Conferences and his Orff Ensembles have performed at two AOSA National Conferences

The Orff-Schulwerk approach encourages students to sing dance and play with a special emphasis on music creativity. The resulting compositions or improvisations are highly sophisticated forms of "knowing in action" that provide ideal opportunities for gauging the richness or depth of a student's musical understanding. This workshop provides models of activities used to elicit students' creative responses as well as procedures that can be used by students and the teacher to help articulate and further develop their own understanding.
